



## **LYON SKI SCHOOL: Transportation Participation Guidelines**

Our goal is to provide a secure environment for your children. Please read & discuss these rules & regulations as a family & direct any questions to Morgan, Linda, or your head chaperone.

### **Misconduct**

The following are grounds for temporary or permanent dismissal from ski school **with no refund**: Possession of a weapon including pocket knives or multi-tools. Possession, sale or consumption of any alcoholic beverages and/or illegal drugs or narcotics, use of any tobacco product including electronic or vapor cigarettes, use of profane language and/or acts of vulgarity, stealing, disruptive or uncooperative behavior, ignoring ski school rules.

- **SERIOUS OFFENSES MAY RESULT IN PARENTS BEING REQUIRED TO PICK-UP CHILD AT MOUNTAIN.**
- The bus driver & chaperones are in full charge of the bus and students while transporting. Students must obey the driver & chaperones promptly and willingly.
- Students are to assist in keeping the bus clean by keeping their garbage off the floor, off of seats and out of vents. Eating will be allowed as long as waste is placed in waste box. **NO POP BOTTLES, CANS ONLY.** Single serving only. Camelbacks must be empty on the bus.
- Nothing may be thrown out windows.
- Students are to remain seated while bus is in motion and not get off bus unless directed.
- Ski/snowboards are unloaded and placed on the ground...never leaned against bus.
- Students will not be allowed to ride other than their scheduled bus.
- Instructors and Chaperones are in charge at the ski area and students must follow their directions.
- Students will ski/snowboard only the areas within their ability and must not ski/snowboard on more difficult terrain. With certain snow conditions, even gentle slopes can be hazardous if not skied/snowboarded under control.
- **Ski/Snowboard with a partner.**
- There will be no tobogganing, sledding, or inner tube sliding while at ski school.
- Students must obey all signs. These are placed for everyone's safety.
- No skiing/snowboarding in the parking lot. No crossing the highway.
- Under no circumstances may students drive themselves to and/or from the mountain.
- Students going home with a parent must submit a letter from their custodial parent to the head chaperone when boarding the bus at noon. The note must include the name of the individual who will be transporting the child. The transporting individual must report to the meeting area before the end of classes & sign the note again, verifying their intention to transport their child home. Be prepared to show ID before your child will be released.
- Students will not be released to ride home with any individual under the age of 21.
- Students enrolled in lessons, must attend class.
- **If an issue arises, it is the student's responsibility to communicate their problem to the ski school director and seek help from a chaperone, instructor Lyon ski School employee IMMEDIATELY.**



## **Bag Check Policy**

All participants riding on a bus as part of a LYON Ski School, Inc. program are required to submit to a mandatory bag check prior to gaining entry to the bus.

*Participants must politely cooperate with the search of their bag.*

Any found items that violate our policies will be confiscated immediately.

- Confiscated items will be released to the parent/guardian of the participant if under age 18 and with proper I.D., except in the case of a found weapon.
- Weapons will be confiscated, held and released to the appropriate law enforcement authority.
- Confiscated items other than weapons, belonging to persons aged 18 and older may be claimed from the Director of Lyon Ski School, Inc., with proper I.D. and by appointment only.

Any individual found to be in possession of a weapon of any sort, will not be allowed on the bus. Parents will be alerted to come pick-up their student.

- Law enforcement will be alerted immediately.
- Buses will NOT be held for parent pick-up of a student in violation of the weapon policy.
- Lyon Ski School, Inc. will NOT provide supervision for a student turned away from the bus for a weapons violation, once law enforcement is on-hand.
